INTRODUCTION

YELLOW WELLIES ARE AN ESSENTIAL PART OF ANY RNLI CREW MEMBER'S KIT. WATERPROOF, WITH STEEL-CAPPED TOES, THESE SPECIALLY DESIGNED BOOTS KEEP THE VOLUNTEER CREWS' FEET WARM AND DRY, AND ALSO PROTECT THEM IN OFTEN DANGEROUS CONDITIONS. DURING GALE FORCE WINDS, RAIN AND ICE, KEEPING A SURE FOOTING ON DECK CAN LITERALLY MEAN THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN LIFE AND DEATH FOR THE RNLI'S BRAVE VOLUNTEERS.

HOW IT WORKS
